Resolution No. _____ of 2023, a resolution declaring a public emergency pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 103(4) within Clifton Park Sewer District #2.

Introduced by _____, who moved its adoption, seconded by _____.

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2023, Clifton Park Sewer District #2 suffered a complete collapse of a sewer main on Town land in the southern portion of Town, and

WHEREAS, Section 103(4) of the NYS General Municipal Law provides that in cases of an emergency situation arising from unforeseen circumstances affecting public buildings or the health or safety of its inhabitants, the Town Board may authorize the purchase of service, material and equipment without competitive bids, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board determines that the sewer main collapse on the day/evening of February 10, 2023, constitutes an emergency for procurement purposes under Section 103(4) of General Municipal Law, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board authorizes Michael O'Brien, Collection Systems Manager, to engage Bellamy Construction Inc., Schultz Highway Construction and such other emergency contractors and/or subcontractors to repair the sewer system and surrounding public and/or private property affected by the collapse, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Comptroller is authorized to charge G11-8111-200 for the expenditures on this project.
