A Health Tip *by Joanne Sweet PHN, Immunization Coordinator, Saratoga County Public Health.....* **Vaccines are not just for kids!**

Immunizations help prevent the spread of communicable diseases. Most vaccines are administered to infants, children and adolescents. Adults need immunizations too. It is recommended that adults have a Tetanus booster (Td) every ten years. At least once in a lifetime, the Tetanus booster should be substituted with a Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis vaccine (Tdap). This vaccine is especially important if an adult will have close contact with an infant less than one year of age. Also it is recommended for adults to receive a Pneumococcal vaccine (Pneumovax and Prevnar), Zostavax vaccine (Shingles), and an annual Flu vaccine.

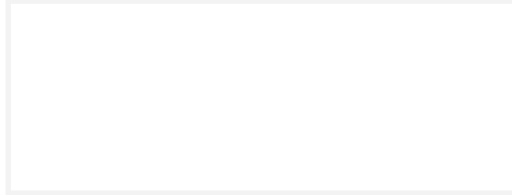
