## **Wednesday, December 11, 2019**

**NY CITIZEN PREPAREDNESS TRAINING PROGRAM** Presented by NY Army National Guard

With severe weather events becoming more frequent and more extreme, it is more important than ever that New Yorkers are prepared for disasters. The Citizen Preparedness Corps is a program led by the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES) and was created by the Governor's Office as a result of Superstorm Sandy. We teach basic principles of emergency preparedness, response, and recovery in order to strengthen our communities in the event of a disaster. We will discuss developing a Family Emergency Plan, building a "Go-Bag", and we now include information on Active Shooter scenarios. The training event is FREE and is instructed by members of the NY Army National Guard.

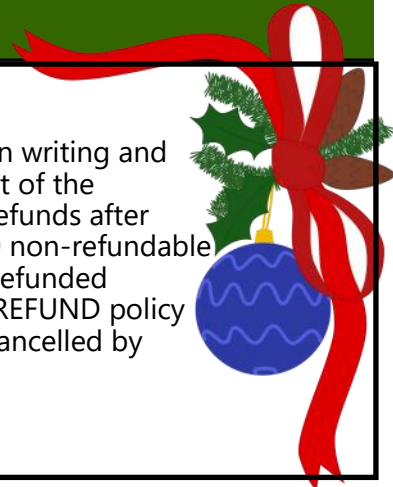
