### 2021 RABIES CLINIC DATES SARATOGA COUNTY

July 20th—September 21th—October 19th

#### Times

Cats are from 5:30 pm until 6:30 pm and the cats must be in carriers.

Dogs are from 6:30 pm until 7:30 pm and the dogs must be on a leash.

Domestic Ferrets from 5:30 pm until 6:30 pm and must be in a cage or carrier.

The rabies clinics is free; however, donations are accepted. All vaccination certificates are written for one year. If a previous signed certificate is produced, a three-year certificate will be written.

**General Rabies Information:** Animal rabies continues to be a serious public health problem in New York State. If you, a family member, or a pet encounters an animal that could be a rabies suspect, you should contact Saratoga County Public Health at (518) 584-7460. They will advise you what to do.

Rabies can be carried by any wild mammal (raccoon, skunk, fox, coyote, or bat). There are also precautionary measures taken if you are bitten by a domestic animal (dog, cat or ferret). If this happens, you should first obtain the owner's name, address and phone number. Then contact the Saratoga County Public Health Department at (518) 584-7460.

### Is your dog licensed with the Town Clerk?

NYS requires all dogs four months of age or older must be licensed in the municipality in which they are harbored. Dog licenses are issued at the Town Clerk's office, located in Town Hall, One Town Hall Plaza, at which time proof of rabies vaccination is required and proof if spayed or neutered.

#### Annual Fee:

Spayed/neutered dog is \$3.50  
Unspayed/unneutered dog is \$11.50

### **\*\*NEW\*\* Online Dog License Renewal**

You may renew your dog(s) license at [www.cliftonpark.org](http://www.cliftonpark.org). Enter the dog tag/license (# starts with 4103\_\_\_\_) and last name. Valid up-to-date rabies certificate must be on file in the Town Clerk's office to be able to proceed with the online payment.

Please keep in mind that this is a renewal system. If you are licensing your dog(s) for the first time, you will need to come to the Town Clerk's office to present a valid rabies certificate as well as a spay or neuter certificate, if applicable.

Please be assured that every precaution has been taken to ensure that your online transactions are safe and secure. You may renew & pay for your dog(s) license online by using your MasterCard, Visa or Discover Credit Cards, Debit Card or Electronic Check. There is a \$1.75 convenience fee added to allow for this online service.

Annual Fee: (See above)

The Town Clerk's office hopes that you find the online dog licensing feature to be a convenient and easy method to renew your dog(s) license.

### **Did you know there are TWO DOG PARKS in Clifton Park?**

The Mary Jane Row Dog Park located on Ray Road and Kinns Road Park located on Kinns Road. A dog park permit can be obtained in the Town Clerk's office, located in Town Hall. Proof of current rabies vaccination and a NYS Dog License are required. An annual \$30.00 fee, per household, allows dogs to be off-leash at both parks. The parks are a wonderful place to take your dog for exercise, playing and socialization.
