## What does the Clifton Park Transfer Station Accept?

**Single stream recycling:** Paper/cardboard/paperback books, clean glass bottles and jars, plastics (numbered 1 through 7), rinsed metal cans

**Automotive Batteries, Tires, Used Automotive Liquids** (antifreeze, motor oil, oil filters, etc.)

**Brush and Leaves -> And pick up free mulch!**

**Clothing and Shoes/Sneakers**

**Demolition/Construction Materials**

**Electronics:** Computers, servers, computer accessories (mice, keyboards, etc.), printers, scanners, fax, desktop copiers, network switches, routers, modems, hubs, cell phones, telephones (commercial/residential), PDAs/Palm Pilots, cameras, camcorders, video equipment, TVs, VCRs, DVD players, stereos, turn tables, circuit boards, video gaming systems, scientific equipment, monitors –  
*Note: Fees to residents for electronics recycling eliminated 1/1/2023*

**Fire Extinguishers (empty)**

**Fireplace Ashes**

**Habitat for Humanity ReStore Donations:** Furniture, appliances, building materials, cabinets, etc. (drop off 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. Wednesdays)

**Large Appliances** (stoves, refrigerators, washers, dryers, microwave ovens, etc.)

**Paints, Finishes, and Stains**

**Propane Tanks**

**Scrap Metal:** Metal dishwashers, metal appliances, metal frames, washers, dryers, refrigerators (door must be taken off), ovens, metal grills, etc. – must be at least 80% metal

**Wooden Pallets -> or pick up free wooden pallets!**
