Wednesday Hikes at Clifton Park's Natural Areas:

1. **Wed., April 2 — Garnsey Park**
2. **Wed., May 7 — Dwaas Kill Nature Preserve.** Meet at the Main Trailhead Kiosk, parking area, 0.36 miles north of Kinns Road, midway along Pierce Road, across from 743 Pierce Rd.
3. **Wed., June 4 — Veterans Memorial Park.** Meet at Picnic Pavilion south of Pickleball.
4. **Wed., July 2 — North Woods Nature Preserve,** Meet at the entrance to the preserve on the south side of the street, between 38 and 40 Shadow Wood Way.
5. **Wed., Sept. 3 — Kinns Road Park**
6. **Wed., Oct. 1 — West Sky Natural Area.** Meet at intersection of Moe Rd. & Tenby Dr. Please park along the south side of Tenby Dr., and we'll start along the Moe Road Trail.
7. **Wed., Nov. 5 — Vischer Ferry Nature & Historic Preserve.** NOTE: Meet Up at the end of Sugar Hill Road at the Dam Overlook.
8. **Wed, Dec. 3 — Mohawk Landing Nature Preserve.**

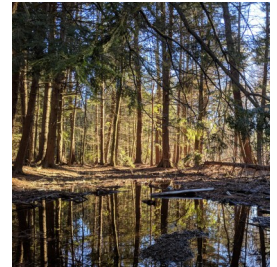
