The Permit is subject to the RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE MARY JANE ROW DOG PARK AND THE RULES APPLICABLE FOR KINNS ROAD PARK. Please carefully read the attached RULES AND REGULATIONS and Safety Guidelines. The Town Clerk's Office will issue the Permits and distribute the Rules and Regulations for use of the Parks, as directed by the Town Board. A copy of the signed application shall be retained in the Town Clerk's Office.

Anyone using the Parks shall do so at their own risk. Dogs must wear Municipality Dog License Tag and Park Permit. The Town of Clifton Park shall have no liability for injury or damage to the dogs or people using the Park. Any information is provided solely to assist residents in safely using the Park and does not imply an expertise or acceptance of any liability on the part of the Town of Clifton Park.

Permittee hereby WAIVES ANY RELEASES AND ALL CLAIMS for damages that may arise from permittees use of the Kinns Road Park and Mary Jane Row Dog Park for off leash dog walking, against the Town of Clifton that I have or may in the future have against the Town of Clifton Park, its officers, employees, agents, security or animal control personnel (all of whom are hereinafter referred to collectively as "THE RELEASEES") and I hereby waive any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury including death that I or my pets may suffer DUE TO ANY CAUSE CLAIM, OR UPON ANY THEORY WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING CLAIMS FOR NEGLIGENCE, Premises Liability, ADEQUACY of Supervision, or any OTHER CAUSE OF ACTION OR THEORY.

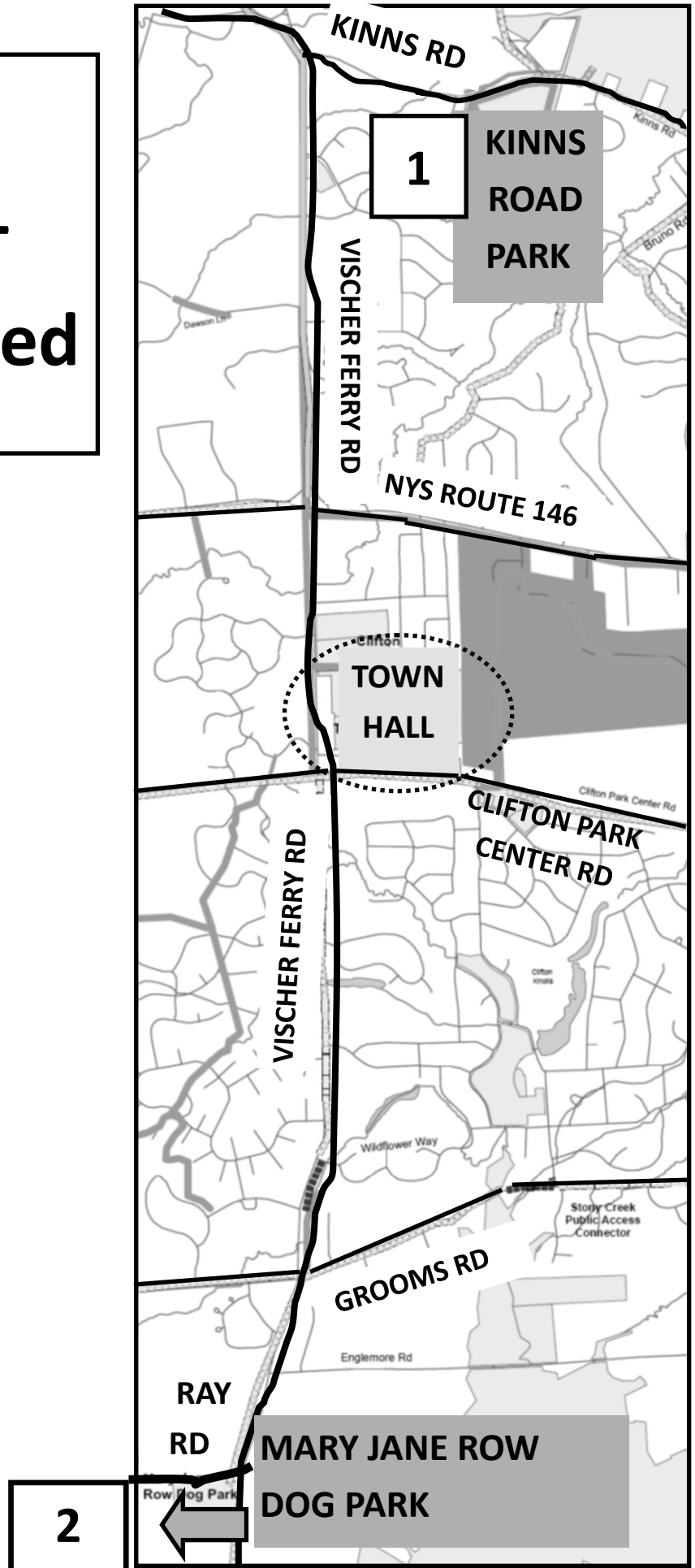

MARY JANE ROW DOG PARK RULES

- ❖ To be allowed in the exercise area dogs must have tags on their collar identifying a valid park permit and a municipality dog license.
- ❖ Owners must clean up after their dogs. (Town Dog Ordinance Chapter 92.6C)
- ❖ No dog is allowed into the exercise area if it is in use without the consent of the other owner. (Please be considerate of waiting dogs and owners by limiting your time.)
- ❖ No food or rawhide allowed in the exercise area.
- ❖ Dogs must be leashed at all times when not in the exercise area.
- ❖ Aggressive dogs cannot enter exercise area when other dogs are present.
- ❖ Female dogs in heat may not enter the exercise area at any time.
- ❖ Dogs must be closely supervised at all times by a responsible adult (18 years or older).
- ❖ Adult supervision of anyone 17 years of age and under is required.
- ❖ The exercise area is subject to all the rules, regulations and procedures governing town parks.
- ❖ Dog Park may not be used for business purposes without express written consent of the Town of Clifton Park.
- ❖ Permit must be clearly displayed on owner(s) car.
- ❖ Enforcement of the above rules is under the immediate supervision of the Town Animal Control Officer. Violation of the above rules is subject to all fines and penalties as set in local laws and ordinances and may also lead to permit being revoked and permit fee forfeited.

KINNS ROAD PARK RULES

- **Dogs must come reliably when called.**
- **Dogs must not approach or touch people or leashed dogs without permission.**
- **Dogs must be leashed when in or entering the parking and picnic areas.**
- **Dogs are not allowed on private property adjoining the park.**
- **Owners must clean up after their dogs. (Town Dog Ordinance Chapter 92.6C)**
- **Do not lose site of your dog(s) at any time.**
- **Dogs must have tags on collar identifying municipality dog license and park permit.**
- **Permittee may only bring up to three (3) dogs at Kinns Road Park at any time.**
- **Permit must be clearly displayed on owners(s) car.**
- **Enforcement of the above rules is under the immediate supervision of the Town Animal Control Officer. Violation of the above rules is subject to all fines and penalties as set in local laws and ordinances and may also lead to permit being revoked and permit fee forfeited.**

ARTICLE IV
Mary Jane Row Dog Park; Kinns Road Park
[Adopted 9-4-2001 by L.L. No. 11-2001]

§ 92-18. Permit required. [Amended 9-15-2008 by L.L. No. 6-2008]

- A. Anyone wishing to utilize the Mary Jane Row Dog Park may do so only after acquiring a permit from the Town Clerk's office. Users are required to abide by the rules and regulations associated with such a permit and issued by the Town Board from time to time. Fees charged for such permit shall be pursuant to a schedule approved by the Town Board from time to time. Fee schedules and copies of the rules and regulations shall be available from the office of the Town Clerk.
- B. Anyone wishing to utilize Kinns Road Park for the purpose of walking or exercising dogs off-leash may do so only after acquiring a permit from the Town Clerk's office. All users are required to abide by the rules and regulations associated with such a permit and issued by the Town Board from time to time, as well as any and all rules posted in Kinns Road Park. Fees charged for such permit shall be pursuant to a schedule approved by the Town Board from time to time. Fee schedules and copies of the rules and regulations shall be available from the office of the Town Clerk.
- C. All dogs at Kinns Road Park must be accompanied by and under the immediate supervision of the owner or other responsible person.
- D. Permits issued pursuant to this section shall be valid in both parks.

§ 92-19. Enforcement.

A violation of this article shall be cited and enforced as otherwise provided in this Chapter 92 of the Town Code.

§ 92-20. Penalties for offenses. [Amended 9-15-2008 by L.L. No. 6-2008; 12-20-2010 by L.L. No. 9-2010]

A person convicted of violating this article shall be deemed to have committed a violation and shall be subject to the penalties provided for in § 92-15.
