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The Town of Clifton Park, through the Buildings & Grounds Department, seeks sealed bids from qualified entities for a town-wide residential curbside bulk waste collection for all residents within the boundaries of The Town of Clifton Park, to be completed between May 6<sup>th</sup> and May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

***Scope of work is as follows but not limited to:***

- The company will be required to provide curbside waste removal of large and bulk items from town residential areas, homes, and apartment complexes and dispose of the items appropriately and lawfully, recycling when and where feasible.
- The company must certify possession of any, and all appropriate licenses and permits to handle transport and disposal of household junk and trash materials in the bid submittal and be able to produce same upon request.
- The company will contact apartment complexes in the town to arrange for delivery and placement of container/dumpsters in the complex for one-time pick-up during this program period.
- Company must complete the removal of all items within a four-week period, ending no later than Saturday May 25, 2024.
- Company will be required to produce and complete a town wide flyer-type mailing, to alert residents of the curbside collection indicating when their pick-up will occur (sample attached). This mailing must be completed and mailed two weeks in advance of the pick-up date. The company is responsible for the printing and mailing of the flyers. The Town of Clifton Park will supply a residential address listing of approximately 15,300 parcels in the form of a spreadsheet.
- Upon completion, the company will submit an itemized program invoice reflecting man hours utilized (certified payrolls), fuel expenses and fees associated with vendor costs, and indicate by category the types and quantities of materials collected and disposed of, disposal fees and any

(recyclables) recycling credits or payments reflecting salvage value obtained for all materials within 30 days of the conclusion of the program.

***Examples of Eligible bulk items:***

- Sofas, couches, loveseats, sleeper sofas, mattresses, furnishings, rugs, etc.
- Appliances and metal items, i.e. stoves, washers, dryers, grills, pipes, lawn mowers, etc.
- Wood scraps, products, i.e. desks, tables, cabinets, wallboard, trim, windows, doors, etc.

***Examples of ineligible items:***

- Hazardous materials \* (solvents, pesticides, chemicals, tires)
- Driveway sealer buckets \*
- Aerosol cans \*
- Propane tanks \*
- Computers & computer monitors, CRT televisions, large screen televisions \*\*
- Household trash and yard debris – grass clippings, branches, or leaves.
- Construction and demolition material.
- Appliances containing freon, which must be handled separately.

\*Residents can dispose of these items during the 2025 household hazardous waste collection day

\*\*electronics recycling is also available at the town transfer station; some fees may apply.

If necessary, Addendums will be posted on the Town website, same location.

Sealed bids must be received at the Town Clerk’s Office at One Town Hall Plaza, Clifton Park, NY, 12065, by 3:00 PM on Thursday February 22, 2024, at which time bids will be opened. Please identify your bid as “Bulk Waste Pick-up 2024”.

***Please clearly submit a lump sum bid.***

The Town requires proof of Liability Insurance with One Million Dollars naming the Town as an additional insured, as well as appropriate Workers Compensation Insurance and automobile insurance.

Prevailing wage rate as described by New York State must be paid. The Town of Clifton Park reserves the right to reject any and all quotes.

The Town of Clifton Park reserves the right to require a performance bond of 5% of the bid price. This bid document is available at [www.cliftonpark.org](http://www.cliftonpark.org) under the government tab. Select request for bid & proposals from drop down menu.

## Acceptable Items

**BULK ITEMS** - Are household items that are non-hazardous, not liquid, and are too big to place in your normal residential garbage container.

**FURNITURE:**

- Sofas • Love Seats • Recliners
- Tables • Chairs • Mattresses • Box Springs
- Rugs/Carpets (4ft or less, must be rolled)
- Patio Furniture

**FIXTURES:**

- Sinks • Toilets • Cabinets
- Doors • Screens

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

- Bicycles • Lawn Mowers
- Weed Wackers/Trimmers
- Automotive Parts (small parts, no oil or gas)
- Small Household Repair Materials

## Not Acceptable Items

**APPLIANCES:**

- Refrigerators • Freezers • Air Conditioners
- or any other item containing Freon

**FIXTURES:**

- Glass Doors • Windows • Tubs • Hot Tubs

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

- Riding Mowers • Televisions • Computers
- Fluorescent Bulbs • Motor Oil • Tree Stumps
- Logs • Yard Waste • Tires • Paints • Stains
- Sealers • Household Chemicals • Decks
- Boats • Wood Sheds • Demolition Material
- Aerosol Cans • Gas Cans • Propane Tanks
- Electronics • Batteries
- Loose Trash or Garbage
